

Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Formwork



Formworkers or “shutter joiners” make temporary wood or metal structures as a mould for pouring wet concrete. Moulds can be used for various construction such as bridges, foundations, beams and staircases and so there is an expectation of precise measuring, cutting and shaping of wood or metal. The frames can often be made elsewhere so a Formworker would also have to put these frames together rectifying any problems on site which could be internal or external.

To achieve this qualification you must be working within this role and also contribute to allocating tasks to a small time.
