

Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Wood Occupations



Carpentry is one of the oldest skilled trades and real profession, the name comes from old French “Charpentier” or carriage maker and wood remains one of the key materials used in construction today. Earliest examples of Carpentry can be found in the Greensted church in England dating back to the 11th Century or the Nanchan Temple, China from the year 782. This qualification will support various job roles within construction,

Bench joiners generally construct door, windows, staircases and use specialist machinery. Shopfitters work from design plans and transform an empty room into a sophisticated interior. Carpenters use specialist tools and a variety of woods often designing and creating bespoke fixtures such as furniture and kitchens.

To achieve this qualification you must be working in a role within wood occupations and also contribute to supervision or allocation of work activities for a small team.
