

Level 6 NVQ Diploma Senior Site Inspection



Site Inspectors can occasionally be referred to “clerk of works” and carry out inspections of a variety of different construction sites across different pathways such as demolition, highways, conservation and building and civil engineering.

Site Inspectors monitor all work carried out on a construction site to ensure safety and standards are upheld. They carry out regular inspections to check the quality of work, identifying any potential problems and then reporting their findings with recommendations for improvements. Often they will have responsibility for supervising the different teams working on a site.

As a Site Inspector, you would work alongside many other teams within a business, such as management or design engineers, and therefore require excellent organisational skills and a strong ability to multitask.

- Manage the project progress and handover in construction
- Monitor test processes in construction
- Manage interaction with others in construction
- Confirm and report on property condition
- Set up and manage technical information systems in construction
